

Agreements signed for Fosthall Creek Run of the River project

A proposed 15 megawatt Run of the River Project in Fosthall Creek near Nakusp is closer to reality.

A development, construction and operation agreement has now been signed between the Splatsin, or Spallumcheen, a tribe of the Shushwap Nation, Fosthall Creek Power Limited, a local developer, and Sorgent.e's Hydro Canada, a multinational group based in Italy.

Lucas De Haro, is the CEO of Sorgent.e..he says the agreement will allow the Splatsin to have a social and environmental benefit from the project, as well as job opportunities.

De Haro says it's an environmentally friendly project on the shore of Upper Arrow Lake, that will include a spawning channel.

Construction is expected to start in 2015.
